

# Hot water to Swallow

The lack of constant hot water for baths and showers was causing great concern for the management of The Swallow International Hotel in London. The situation at the Swallow chain's flagship location in the capital's Cromwell Road has now been rectified thanks to a carefully engineered refurbishment of its rooftop plant room; featuring the introduction of two Stokvis Econoplate plate heat exchangers as a means of providing instantaneous hot water to all of the guest rooms and back of house areas.
